

#### 1. Width

Indicates the width of the tyre in millimetres, eg 215mm

# 2. Aspect Ratio/Sidewall

Indicates the sidewall height, eg 60% of the width (215), gives you the height of the sidewall

### 3. Tyre construction

R = Indicates the radial tyre construction

#### 4. Wheel Diameter

Indicates the diameter of the wheel rim in inches, e.g. 16 inch

# 5. Load Rating

Indicates the maximum load capacity of the tyre, eg 95 means each tyre can take up to 690kg.

The greater the load index number, the more weight each tyre can carry. Below are some of the common Load rating symbols and their corresponding maximum load ratings (kg).

# 6. Speed Rating

Indicates the maximum speed rating of the tyre, eg V = rated for a max speed of 240km/h

Below are some of the common Speed symbols and their corresponding maximum speed ratings (km/h)
